# Otago-SWU MAppSc in AI/CS/Tele

### **Co-education Project Proposal**

### **Project overview**


During the last several months, there have been several online meetings between the two working groups at Otago and SWU, and one on-campus meeting with the delegation of SWU in Dr. Hu Zhang's office at Otago. After several rounds of discussion, the initial agreement is to start with the following three directions:

- MAppSc in Al
- MAppSc in Computer Science
- MAppSc in Telecommunications

#### Pathways: 1+1 and 2+1

The number of students coming to Otago for the new program is expected to be 20-30 per year, with the following proposed model:

- 1+1: 1 year in SWU and 1 year in Otago, receiving Otago degree only
- 2+1: 2 years in SWU and 1 year in Otago, receiving both Otago and SWU degree



According to Otago's current requirements for MAppSc, 180 points are needed for MAppSc in Tele/Al/CS. The initial proposed requirements for the new program, Otago-SWU MAppSc in Tele/Al/CS, is as follows:

- 60 points to be cross-credited from SWU
- 120 points obtained from Otago (80 points + 40 points for project)

Students will study at SWU during the first year (for the 1+1 model), or the first two years (for the 2+1 model), and then can choose one of the three directions, as illustrated below:
